When RSVP please indicate if you are planning on staying at the Armory, Pizza party Friday night and Breakfast. Numbers matter when ordering and planning.

Mandatory Coaches meeting- Saturday Morning at the National Guard Armory @ 7:30 – Safety is first and foremost, will have latest ice conditions, off limits areas and accountability is critical must turn in indemnification agreement sheets listing all team members and coaches going out and at least one contact number.

This is a catch and release tournament- Releasing of fish is encouraged but teams are free to keep any legal fish for personal consumption. Fish are to be measured for total inches then recorded on tournament weigh in sheet. Teams will be given a scratch sheet and turn in sheet. Scratch sheet can be used for tracking inches but then ten best fish to be transferred to turn in sheet for turn in.

Species that count for total weight – Walleye, Northern Pike, Muskellunge, Lake Trout, Smallmouth Bass, Whitefish, Splake, Brown Trout, Coho and King salmon, Perch and Bluegill. **THIS YEAR THERE WILL BE BONUS POINTS awarded FOR ONE OF ANY SPECIES NOT MENTIONED ABOVE BUT MUST COUNT AS PART OF YOUR TEN FISH TOTAL. i.e. Smelt, Cisco, Catfish, etc.**

GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES AND FORMAT

Weigh in is at 3:00- Any teams that have not submitted their respective weigh in sheet to tournament director by 3:00 can face disqualification.

- Tournament start time is 8:00am- Teams may be staged on ice but one coach must be at tournament meeting at 7:30am. No lines in the water until 8:00am.
- Fishing end time is 2:30 and weigh in is at 3:00pm. Teams are expected to have team captain or coach hand in official turn in sheet to tournament director no later than 3:00PM.
- Adult coaches may fish but their fish WILL not count. Only fish caught by student anglers will count for team total.
- Coaches are expected to verify each fish measured. This is on the honor system and I expect coaches to be great stewards of honesty and integrity.
- No more than ten student anglers per team. Schools with more than ten anglers must split teams into multiple teams.
